#### **Renewal Meetings – Please Read Carefully**

Club dues are on the calendar year basis and you have until January 31st to renew. After that, you cannot participate in Club events until you renew. The Club will be holding several membership renewal meetings as shown above. You can also mail your renewal as shown on the Application. To renew at the meetings, you will need to bring along:

- **A completed and legible 2015 Application form (available at [http://pball.grandpickleball.org/Forms/mem\\_app.pdf](http://pball.grandpickleball.org/Forms/mem_app.pdf)).**
- **Your CAM card**
- **Payment – either a check drawn on a bank in the USA or cash**

If you completed your 2014 monitoring requirement, the 2015 dues will be \$5. If you haven't completed the monitoring requirement, the dues will be \$25. Check the Club Roster to see if you have received credit for monitoring. If you have monitored but haven't received credit, contact Bob Julian, Monitor Chairman (623-214-7886) to get it corrected.
